ST. PAUL'S METAPHOR FOR CHRISTIAN LIFE

What is life, in the mind of St Paul? What is the metaphor he uses to make sense of everything he experiences? St Paul sees his life as an athletic contest, as a battle that demands an exhausting effort - an effort that he has always made. "I have competed well," he writes, "I have finished the race; I have kept the faith."



- He has "competed well" - he never gave into laziness, but followed Christ with all his heart.
- He has "finished the race" - he persevered to the end; he didn't just give the appearance of being a Christian, but he lived like a Christian, day in and day out; he talked the talk, but he also walked the walk, tirelessly bearing witness to his Lord in word and deed.
- He has kept the faith - he never let his pride blind him, he accepted Christ's teaching as the truth, he played by God's rules, not trying to re-write them to fit his own desires, but humbly following his Lord.



MESSAGE:

Too often we forget that our life on earth is short, and that its goal is heaven, the "crown of righteousness" that Paul says awaits him.

Too often we look for perfect peace and joy here, on this arena that we call earth. But we will never find it here. This life is the place of contest.

Here we run the race, and our joy is the joy of the athlete who is giving his best in the face of difficulties and challenges - the athlete who knows that victory is assured if only he keeps on fighting.

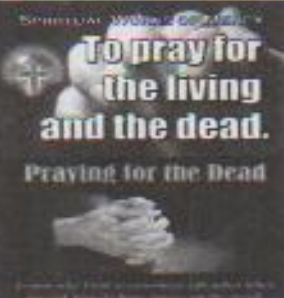
