## Growing In Humility by Gaining Indulgences

If the **essence** of humility is thinking **more** about **God and others** than about **oneself**, **growing** in humility means **training** ourselves to do just that, which is a **life-long project**.

- **Prayer** is essential here, by **turning our attention** towards God.
- **Reading the Bible** is essential as well, because it presents us with Christ's perfect **example** of humility.

Another simple and practical way to **exercise humility** is **praying for the souls in Purgatory**.

- Most of us die without having been **completely purified** from our self-centered habits and desires.
- If we die in **friendship with Christ**, we will enter eternal life with him in heaven, but we can't make that entry until the **last remnants of self-centeredness have been purified**.
- **Purgatory** is the name the Church gives to that **process of purification**.

The Church has also taught us that we can **pray** for the souls in Purgatory, and we can even **help speed up** their purification.

An **Indulgence** is the name the Church gives to this **speeding up of the purification process** in Purgatory. We can gain **small indulgences** for the souls in Purgatory, **relieving** their suffering and **speeding** up their entry into heaven by following all actions of the church that are linked to indulgences.

Like a good mother, the Church has made it **easy** for us to help our brothers and sisters in Purgatory. And whenever we do, we are opening our hearts to **God and to others**, thereby exercising the **pivotal virtue of humility**, the key to holiness and happiness.
